### Mathew W. Freeman Memorial Scholarship

Deadline is May 1, 2020.

**Eligibility**: The applicant must be a dependent or relative of a member of VVA 920, Denton, TX. Immediate family members of Honorably Discharged Vietnam or Vietnam-Era: e.g. (spouse, children including foster or stepchildren, or grandchildren.

The Mathew W. Freeman Memorial Scholarship application has been updated for 2020 and now includes a Vietnam Veteran interview and essay.

### Interview/Essay

- > The applicant is to interview a Vietnam or Vietnam-Era veteran.
- ➤ Upon completion of the interview, the applicant is to write a formal paper which explains what the interviewer learned from the Veteran. The committee estimates that this formal paper should be approximately 1,000 words to adequately "tell the veteran's story".
- ➤ The committee recommends that the veteran selected NOT be a relative! The story you receive from a non-relative will provide new and additional insights of the person's experiences.

Please encourage your family members to participate. Full scholarship requirements and explanations are on the Application form.

VVA 920 will award five \$1,000.00 Scholarships in 2020.
