## Military and Veteran Benefits Lunch & Learn

For Spouses & Surviving Spouses

Recent changes to Federal benefits make it even more important to learn about benefits you may be eligible for as a Military or Veteran Spouse or as a Surviving Spouse.

Like U.S. military Veterans themselves, spouses of Veterans are eligible to receive a variety of benefits and compensation through the Veterans Administration (VA). Those benefits may include health care coverage, survivors' pension, education aid and job training, career counseling, home loans, grief counseling, and final arrangements.

For example, did you know that you may be eligible for a monthly stipend of \$1,500+ from the VA, if your spouse died due to a service-connected illness under the New PACT Act? Did you know that you may be eligible for special employment considerations under VA and/or Texas Law? Want to learn more?
